

KRESCENT Summer Studentship Program Application Process

STEP 1

View the list of supervisors with available summer positions and rank your top 3.

STEP 2

Complete and submit an application.

Interested and eligible Black and Indigenous undergraduate students are asked to submit:

- 1. A statement of intent (up to 1 page, single spaced 11 pt font) describing their interest in kidney research, their career goals and how they anticipate that they will benefit from the program. Note that previous experience with research is not a requirement for the program; applicants are encouraged to share their motivation to do research as well as any community or cultural experience that may lend to the studentship.
- 2. Curriculum vitae (please include your current location)
- 3. Two letters of support (academic, community based or cultural leader). Please note that the letter of support should help to show the applicants overall drive and motivation for research, highlight their community engagement, and give the selection committee a snapshot of who you are.
